Dear Minister Struthers:

Bill 6, The East Side Traditional Lands Planning and Special Protected Areas Act RE: MKO Support - January 19, 2008 Letter of God's Lake First Nation

I am writing further to the January 19, 2009 letter to you from Chief Gilbert Andrews of the God's Lake First Nation regarding Bill 6, The East Side Traditional Lands Planning and Special Protected Areas Act:

- MKO agrees that Bill 6 was not developed on a "government-to-government basis" under Article 1. 1.1 of the April 3, 2007 Wabanong Nakaygum Okimawin (WNO) Council of Chiefs Accord nor with the "First Nations governments' participation and approval" called for under Article 3.8" of the Accord;
- MKO agrees that Bill 6 is not founded on the core principle that the planning and management of 2. First Nation traditional territories will be carried out through a co-decision authority exercised jointly between Chief and Council and Manitoba such as has been established pursuant to the Northern Flood Agreement and so will undermine the "long tradition of co-management in northern Manitoba" referred to by Chief Andrews;
- MKO is very concerned that s. 22 of Bill 6 represents a prerequisite that a participating First 3. Nation must accept as lawful all existing authorizations within that First Nation's Traditional territory whether or not an existing authorization may be unlawful due to Manitoba's failure to have conducted a First Nation-Crown consultation process regarding the authorization; and
- Manitoba must engage a duty to consult, justify and accommodate in respect of the proposed East 4. Side Traditional Lands Planning and Special Protected Areas Act, particularly as Manitoba proposes that Bill 6 and its regulations would be paramount to all other provincial laws.

In light of the concerns raised by Chief Andrews, MKO requests that Manitoba defer any further consideration of Bill 6 until these matters have been addressed to the satisfaction of the God's Lake First Nation. Please contact me at (204) 792-8120 to discuss these matters.
